We are offering all of our Craftsman Demonstration booths for FREE providing you are able to offer festival-goers several demonstrations throughout the day. Your demonstrations can be ongoing or at specific intervals throughout the festival. We do ask that you let us know your schedule so that we can advertise and promote accordingly.

You will need to bring any and all tables, chairs, tents, etc. for your booth. The approximate size is 10x10 feet. Electricity is not available; however, you are permitted to bring a small generator.

Setup will take place from 8:00 am to 9:30 am on Saturday, July 13, 2019. You MUST be setup by 9:30am. Mountain Heritage Festival is open free to the public from 10am-3pm. Vendors should not plan to take down early.

No vehicles are allowed on the field from 9:30 am until 3:00pm. Free parking is conveniently located at the East Fork Baptist Church directly across the street from the festival.
